Mr. Newington reviewed the Kalamazoo County Health Department data as presented on their website.

Kalamazoo County is on an eight-week trend of increased COVID-19 cases and an increase in percentage of cases tested that are positive. There are signs of a plateau showing but it is too early to tell. Kalamazoo County is above the state average in the number of people who have been fully vaccinated and have initiated it.

State - 636.9 daily/million with 30 deaths, upward trend

Region ~ 501 daily/million with 5 deaths, upward trend

County - 518.2 daily/million with 3 deaths, upward trend
