

Para-Professional Position for Behavioral Support for 2018-2019

Work Schedule: Approximately 9:00 – 3:30 p.m. Monday – Friday

Duties will include meeting with students in Grades K-5 to problem-solve minor discipline issues. Duties may also involve referral-writing and communicating with parents, assisting with sick children, reading support, small group instruction, recess/café supervision, etc.

Must understand problem-solving disciplinary issues utilizing the PBIS system of supports. Must be flexible and able to work well within a team. Must enjoy working with young children beginning at Pre-K age and willing to carry out lessons and tasks as directed by principal and classroom teacher.

Experience working with students' disciplinary issues and problem -solving utilizing PBIS strategies is preferred.

The No Child Left behind Act mandates that all para-professional support educators meet certain educational requirements. This position requires someone to be "Highly Qualified" which would be either an Associate's Degree or passage of special testing in math, reading, and writing.
