

What is Title One?

Title One is a federally funded program that identifies students most in need of additional reading or math assistance. We work with students to provide additional intervention help in a core subject, set goals, and monitor progress.

Our program provides parent night training and resources to engage students and parents at home. At Climax-Scotts Elementary we have a coordinator and a team of trained paraprofessionals that assist with a variety of programs.

Lauren MacVicar is our C-S literacy coach and serves as the coordinator that trains our paraprofessionals, works with classroom teachers, along with monitoring data to make sure students are placed in appropriate intervention groups. She uses specific goal data to determine which intervention is appropriate for your student and continues to monitor progress to assist in any necessary intervention change. Students learn the foundation of reading with phonemic awareness and phonics then build an understanding of how to decode and expand vocabulary. Fluency and comprehension grow as they apply these skills to leveled reading passages.
